

Genesis 22:9-17-NLT

9 When they arrived at the place where God had told him to go, Abraham built an altar and arranged the wood on it. Then he tied his son, Isaac, and laid him on the altar on top of the wood.

10 And Abraham picked up the knife to kill his son as a sacrifice.

11 At that moment the angel of the LORD called to him from heaven, "Abraham! Abraham!" "Yes," Abraham replied. "Here I am!"

12 "Don't lay a hand on the boy!" the angel said. "Do not hurt him in any way, for now I know that you truly fear God. You have not withheld from Me even your son, your only son."

13 Then Abraham looked up and saw a ram caught by its horns in a thicket. So he took the ram and sacrificed it as a burnt offering in place of his son.

14 Abraham named the place Yahweh-Yireh (which means "the LORD will provide"). To this day, people still use that name as a proverb: "On the mountain of the LORD it will be provided."

15 Then the angel of the LORD called again to Abraham from heaven.

16 "This is what the LORD says: Because you have obeyed Me and have not withheld even your son, your only son, I swear by My own name that...

17 I will certainly bless you...

1. GOD SEE'S AHEAD FOR WHAT YOU NEED FOR TODAY.

Verse 13... Then Abraham looked up and saw a ram caught by its horns in a thicket. So he took the ram and sacrificed it as a burnt offering in place of his son.

Yir'eh - "to see."

Provide –(Latin) *providēre* - "to see ahead," ...taking precautionary measures in preparation to meet a need.

It also means - "Yahweh appears." "On the mount the Lord appears."

Philippians 4:19-AMP

19 And my God will liberally supply (fill to the full) your every need according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

Passion Bible – 19 *I am convinced that my God shall fully satisfy every need you have, for I have seen the abundant riches of glory revealed to me through the Anointed One, Jesus Christ!*

2. WE HAVE TO SEE AND BELIEVE BY FAITH THAT GOD WILL PROVIDE FOR US.

Genesis 22:5,7-8-AMP

5 "Stay here with the donkey," Abraham told the servants. "The boy and I will

travel a little farther. We will worship there, and then we will come right back."

7 And Isaac said to Abraham, My father! And he said, Here I am, my son. [Isaac] said, See, here are the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for the burnt sacrifice?

8 Abraham said, My son, God Himself will provide a lamb for the burnt offering. So the two went on together.

Hebrews 11:20-AMP

20 [With eyes of] faith Isaac, looking far into the future, invoked blessings upon Jacob and Esau.

Mark 9:22-23-PASSION

But please, if you're able to do something, anything—have compassion on us and help us!"

23 Jesus said to him, "What do you mean 'if'? If you are able to believe, all things are possible to the believer."

2Corinthians 9:8-11-AMP

8 And God is able to make all grace (every favor and earthly blessing) come to you in abundance, so that you may always and under all circumstances and whatever the need be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation].

9 As it is written, He [the benevolent person] scatters abroad; He gives to the poor: His deeds of justice and goodness and kindness and benevolence will go on and endure forever! [Ps. 112:9.]

10 And [God] Who provides seed for the sower and bread for eating will also provide and multiply your [resources for] sowing and increase the fruits of your righteousness [which manifests itself in active goodness, kindness, and charity].

11 Thus you will be enriched in all things and in every way, so that you can be generous, and [your generosity as it is] administered by us will bring forth thanksgiving to God.

1Corinthians 16:1-2- AMP

1 NOW CONCERNING the money contributed for [the relief of] the saints (God's people): you are to do the same as I directed the churches of Galatia to do.

2 On the first [day] of each week, let each one of you [personally] put aside something and save it up as he has prospered [in proportion to what he is given], so that no collections will need to be taken after I come.

Ephesians 4:28-AMP

Let the thief steal no more, but rather let him be industrious, making an honest living with his own hands, so that he may be able to give to those in need.

3. BEING OBEDIENT IS A REQUIREMENT FOR GOD MEETING OUR NEEDS.

Verse 16-17 of Genesis 22 - 16 "This is what the LORD says: Because you have obeyed Me and have not withheld even your son, your only son, I swear by My own name that... 17 I will certainly bless you...

Philippians 4:16 -18-AMP

For even in Thessalonica you sent [me contributions] for my needs, not only once but a second time.

17 Not that I seek or am eager for [your] gift, but I do seek and am eager for the fruit which increases to your credit [the harvest of blessing that is accumulating to your account].

18 But I have [your full payment] and more; I have everything I need and am amply supplied. now that I have received from Epaphroditus the gifts you sent me. [They are the] fragrant odor of an offering and sacrifice which God welcomes and in which He delights.

a. We have to be God's servant, obeying God, no matter the price.

Matthew 6:30-33-Passion Bible

30 So if God has clothed the meadow with hay, which is here for such a short time and then dried up and burned, won't he provide for you the clothes you need—even though you live with such little faith?

31 " So then, forsake your worries! Why would you say, 'What will we eat?' or 'What will we drink?' 'What will we wear?'

32 For that is what the unbelievers chase after. Doesn't your heavenly Father already know the things your bodies require?

33 " So above all, constantly chase after the realm of God's kingdom (Above all, pray for the kingdom realm of God) and the righteousness that proceeds from him. Then all these less important things will be given to you abundantly

34 Refuse to worry about tomorrow, but deal with each challenge that comes your way, one day at a time. Tomorrow will take care of itself."
