

THE GLORY OF GOD
Sunday, March 8th, 2026
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1 Timothy 6:15-Passion

15 Yes, God will make his appearing in his own divine timing, for he is the exalted God, the only powerful One, the King over every king, and the Lord of power!
16 He alone is the immortal God, living in the unapproachable light of divine glory! No one has ever seen his fullness, nor can they, for all the glory and endless authority of the universe belongs to him, forever and ever. Amen!

What is the glory of the Lord?

Exodus 33:18-19-NKJV

And he said, "Please, show me Your glory."

19 Then He said, "I will make all My goodness pass before you, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before you. I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion."

glory - Hebrew - *kabod* - *"the weight of something."* It also speaks of majesty and honor. All of God's goodness.

goodness - Hebrew - is defined as *"good in the widest sense."* In other words, nothing is withheld.

1 Corinthians 13:12 KJV

"For *now* we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face"

The glory of the Lord is everything that makes God, God. All His characteristics, authority, power, wisdom—literally the immeasurable weight and magnitude of God.

God values you as much as He values Jesus.

John 17:23

"The world will know that you [God] sent me [Jesus Christ] and that you love them as much as you love me."

Luke 12:4-5-Passion

4 "Listen, my beloved friends, don't fear those who may want to take your life but nothing more. It's true that they may kill your body, but they have no power over your soul.

5 The one you must fear is God, for he has both the power to take your life and the authority to cast your soul into hell. Yes, the only one you need to fear is God.

Luke 12:6-7 NKJV

Are not five sparrows sold for two copper coins? And not one of them is forgotten before God. But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Do not fear; therefore, you are of more value than many sparrows.

Psalm 49:7-9

They cannot redeem themselves from death by paying a ransom to God. Redemption does not come so easily, for no one can ever pay enough to live forever.

Psalm 139:17-18 NKJV

How precious also are Your thoughts to me, O God! How great is the sum of them! If I should count them, they would be more in number than the sand.

Luke 16:15-Passion

John 3: 16 NKJV
