1. GODS UNCONDITIONAL LOVE MOVES HIM TO UNCONDITIONAL MERCY.

Ephesians 2:4 – AMP.

But God--so rich is He in His mercy! Because of and in order to satisfy the great and wonderful and intense love with which He loved us,...

Mercy - The outward manifestation of God's **compassion**. Intentionally place oneself in a situation in which one must rely on someone else to be compassionate or lenient towards one.

The scriptures Bible - But Elohim, who is rich in compassion, because of His great love with which He loved us, ...

2. ASKING GOD FOR HIS MERCY IS ASKING GOD FOR A FAVOR.

Psalms 86:15-17-NLT

... But You, O Lord, are a God of compassion and mercy, slow to get angry and filled with unfailing love and faithfulness.

16 Look down and have mercy on me. Give Your strength to Your servant; save me, the son of Your servant.

17 Send me a sign of Your favor....

TLB - But you are merciful and gentle, Lord, slow in getting angry, full of constant loving-kindness and of truth;

16 so look down in pity and grant strength to your servant and save me.

17 Send me a sign of your favor.

Pity - *the feeling of sorrow and compassion caused by the suffering and misfortunes of others...*

Mark 10:46-52-NLT

... Then they reached Jericho, and as Jesus and His disciples left town, a large crowd followed Him. A blind beggar named Bartimaeus (son of Timaeus) was sitting beside the road.

47 When Bartimaeus heard that Jesus of Nazareth was nearby, he began to shout, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!"

48 "Be quiet!" many of the people yelled at him. But he only shouted louder, "Son of David, have mercy on me!"

49 When Jesus heard him, He stopped and said, "Tell him to come here." So they

called the blind man. "Cheer up," they said. "Come on, He's calling you!"

50 Bartimaeus threw aside his coat, jumped up, and came to Jesus.

51 "What do you want Me to do for you?" Jesus asked. "My rabbi, " the blind man said, "I want to see!"

52 And Jesus said to him, "Go, for your faith has healed you." Instantly the man could see, and he followed Jesus down the road.

Passion - "Son of David, have **mercy on me now and heal me!**"

Matthew 20:34-EMTV

.... And Jesus, having compassion, touched their eyes, and immediately their eyes received sight, and they followed Him.

Message - ... Deeply moved, Jesus touched their eyes.

CJB - ... Filled with tenderness, Yeshua touched their eyes;...

Passion - Jesus was deeply moved with compassion toward them. So, he touched their eyes, and instantly they could see!

3. WE CAN RECEIVE FREELY HIS MERCY, FAVOR, COMPASSION BECAUSE HE HIMSELF FELT OUR NEED FOR THE MERCY, FAVOR, AND COMPASSION.

Hebrews 4:15-16-the scriptures

... For we do not have a High Priest unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who was tried in all respects as we are, apart from sin.

16 Therefore, let us come boldly to the throne of favour, in order to receive compassion, and find favour for timely help.

AMPLIFIED BIBLE - ... Let us then fearlessly and confidently and boldly draw near to the throne of grace (the throne of God's unmerited favor to us sinners), that we may receive mercy [for our failures] and find grace to help in good time for every need [appropriate help and well-timed help, coming just when we need it].

Passion - ... to receive mercy's kiss and discover the grace we urgently need to strengthen us in our time of weakness.

Jude 1:21-AMP.

... Guard and keep yourselves in the love of God; expect and patiently wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ (the Messiah)--[which will bring you] unto life eternal.
